»» NEW RULES TO PROTECT HIV, AIDS VICTIMS

KUALA LUMPUR — The government wants to draft a new regulation to stop discrimination against people living with HIV or AIDS in the workplace. Human Resources Minister Datuk Seri Dr Richard Riot Jaem said the ministry planned to make a holistic review on all its existing acts before coming out with the draft. “Engagement (with all key players) is very important in this,” he told reporters at the Malaysian Business Consortium on HIV/AIDS Forum 2017. Riot said currently companies were only guided by non-compulsory ‘Code of Practice on Prevention and Management of HIV and AIDS’ developed by the Department of Occupational Safety and Health in 2001. Since its introduction, only 42 companies had adopted it. “What we have now is only a guidance, voluntary basis. We intend to make it obligatory,” he said. — Bernama
