## New regulation to eliminate discrimination against people with HIV and AIDS at workplace soon

KUALA LUMPUR: The government wants to draft a new regulation in an effort to eliminate discrimination against people living with HIV or AIDS at the workplace, said Human Resources Minister Datuk Seri Dr Richard Riot Jaem.

In this respect, he said the ministry

planned to make a holistic review on all its existing acts before coming out with a draft and bringing it to the Attorney-General's Chambers, before proceeding to the next step.

However, he said, there was no definite timeline yet as to when the draft would be

ready.

"But of course engagement (with all the key players) is very important in this," he told reporters when met after delivering his speech at the Malaysian Business Consortium on HIV/AIDS Forum 2017 here on Friday. —Bernama
