'Use a condom, be faithful'

JOHANNESBURG: Archbishop Emeritus Desmond Tutu got a lesson on how to put on a condom yesterday when he celebrated the first birthday of the Tutu Tester, a mobile HIV and TB testing facility. Though the vehicle was put into service in the Cape Town area a year ago, and had tested 10,000 people, Tutu had never seen it. So yesterday, he cut a chocolate birthday cake, got tested, and received a lesson from Sister Liz Thebus on how to unroll a condom onto a demonstration wooden penis. "I've been made to do things, strange things, fitting a condom," he told journalists afterwards, hiding his face in mock embarrassment. "Let's make sure we destroy HIV," he said. "And the only way to be cured of HIV is not to be infected. So for goodness' sake know your status, use a condom, be faithful."
