HIV screening procedures

THE test is easy, simple, painless and available for free at all government health clinics.

Personal information and test results are confidential.

1. Sign-in at registration counters.
2. Consult the medical personnel on duty for an

HIV test.

3. The medical personnel will provide advice and counselling before performing the test.
4. A finger prick test is performed which can show results in 15 minutes using Rapid Test Kits.
5. If the results of the screening are found to be “not

reactive”, a briefing will be performed. High-risk individuals will be advised to repeat the test in six months.

6. If the results of the screening are found to be “reactive”, counselling will be provided to obtain consent to continue with a verification test.
