Bids to break AIDS ribbon record

JOHANNESBURG: South Africa, which has the world's largest HIV caseload, on Saturday unveiled a 1.5km long AIDS ribbon in Johannesburg, beating a record of one kilometre previously held by India. Created from over 6,000 red T-shirts pinned together, the ribbon was rolled out starting at

the Constitution Hill, which houses the country's Constitutional Court, and unfurled through the streets of Braamfontein. The ribbon is seen as a "visual symbol of the country's commitment to eradicating HIV/AIDS" in a country where six of the 51.8 million inhabitants live with the virus. — AFP
