Open to all printmaking artists from around the world, participants can submit a maximum of four prints. All forms of two-dimensional printmaking techniques are accepted.

The size of the paper should be no smaller than 20cm x 30cm and no larger than 60cm x 80cm. No fee is required. However, each artist must donate at least one print to the organisers' permanent collection. Submission deadline is June 30.

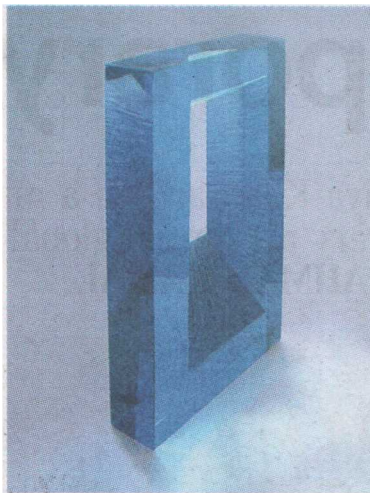
