MALAYSIA PLAYS A PART

In its centenary celebration, L'Oréal Malaysia has joined hands with Malaysian AIDS Foundation to help make a difference in the lives of HIV/AIDS infected and affected children. Through the K.I.S.S. programme (Keep In School Scheme), 100 children aged 12 years and above who are affected or infected with HIV/AIDS will have financial support to continue with their secondary education and have a chance at a better future.
