87,000 in Malaysia found to have HIV

LUMUT: Some 87,000 people in Malaysia were identified to have been infected with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), with the average rate of 10 people being infected daily, said Malaysian AIDS Council President Datuk Mohd Zaman Khan.

"The increase in the number of HIV-infected people in the country is very worrying and should be given proper attention.

"Since the first HIV case was reported in 1986, Malaysia was said to have striven to check the spread of the deadly disease (AIDS) but to no avail," he said after the opening of a seminar and exhibition on HIV/AIDS and Islamic Forum at the Royal Malaysian Navy (RMN) base, here, Sunday.

He said only in the past few years, had efforts to combat HIV infection in the country shown some positive results.
