Blood donation campaign at National Mosque on Friday

KUALA LUMPUR: The National Mosque is again organising a blood-donation campaign to assist the National Blood Bank in conjunction with the Warriors' Day which falls on 31 July.

A statement from the public relations and resource centre of the mosque said yesterday the programme, which would be held on Friday 29 July, was aimed at creating early awareness among the public on their health care.

Several government departments and agencies will be participating in the programme including the Health Department, Department of Islamic Development (JAKIM), National Transplant Resource Centre, National Anti-Drugs Agency, Malaysian Aids Council and the Muslim Women Foundation (YATI).

A free dental check-up will also be given to the public while the Election Commission is setting up a counter to register new voters.
