Namibia signs declaration on zero new HIV infections

MAPUTO: Namibia has signed a declaration on 'Zero New HIV Infections' on Friday at the Joaquim Chissano Conference Centre here, according to Namibian Press Agency (Nampa).

The declaration, which was launched earlier under the theme 'Give Aids the Red Card', was signed by more than 10 countries that are participating in this year's 10th All Africa Games.

The objective of signing the declaration is to support efforts against further HIV infections. The campaign is also against any form of discrimination for people who are infected with HIV.

Namibia is one of the 47 countries participating at the All Africa Games, and was the third country to have arrived in Mozambique for the games.

Senior Advisor to the Executive Director of the UNAIDS, Dr Djibril Diallo said the launch is a symbol of action, and shows the way forward to building new movements through sports by mobilising the youth to become the agents of change. — Bernama
