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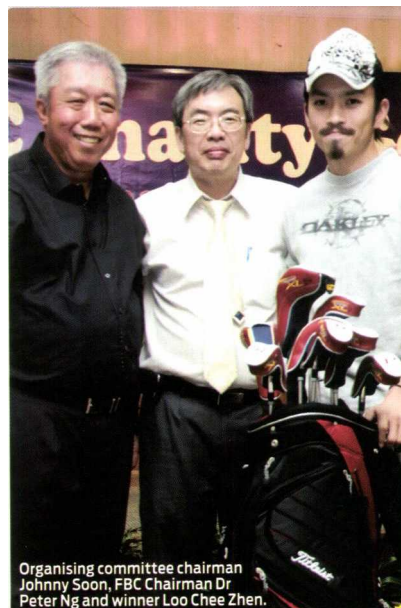
## RM25,000 raised at charity event

Loo Chee Zhen claimed a one-point victory in the inaugural FBC Charity Golf Tournament at the Kelab Rekreasi Tentera Udara (KRTU) golf course on September 23, 2011 but the biggest winners were two charity homes – the Rumah Victory and Crisis Home.
