## US committed to AIDS-free generation: Hillary

WASHINGTON: US Secretary of State Hillary Clinton vowed that the United States will step up the fight against HIV, insisting it was working towards the goal of achieving an AIDS-free generation.

Amid worrying research showing that resistance to AIDS drugs is growing in parts of Africa, Clinton unveiled more than \$150 million in new funding to battle the pandemic.

"The United States is committed and will remain committed to achieving an AIDS-free generation. We will not back off, we will not back down," Clinton told participants at the International AIDS Conference in Washington.

"We will fight for the resources necessary to

achieve this historic milestone," she added, dismissing criticism that the United States was not serious in its bid to fight the 30-year pandemic.

Some 1.5 million people died from the disease last year, and some 34 million people globally are living with HIV, according to the latest UNAIDS report.- AFP
