The annual charity event is another effort by Hard Rock Cafe in nurturing a caring spirit and attitude among its staff for less fortunate individuals.

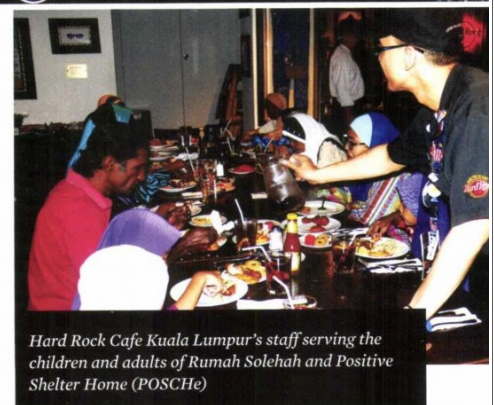
Apart from feasting on the buka puasa buffet spread, the women and children also enjoyed music while sharing some light moments with one another.
