Jimmy Choo will donate 25% of the net sales from Project PEP to the foundation to

support the Simelela Rape Centre in Cape Town.

The centre was set up in 2005 with the mission to administer victims of abuse with the vital HIV preventative Post Exposure Prophylaxis medication and provide the infrastructure for medical, counselling and legal support.

The proceeds raised by Project PEP will enable the clinic to provide 24-hour access to the vital life-saving treatment that has to be administered within the first 72 hours of exposure to HIV.

The Project PEP collection of tote bags, clutches, ballet flats, signature heels and

flip flops will be available in Jimmy Choo stores worldwide.
