Coming in second was team Cryptically Challenged consisting of Alexander Hoh, Andre Teh, Rosemawarni A. Rahman and Mohd Shahrin Zainuddin while team 2 Sneakies and 2 Innocents consisting of Wong Chiang Chuen, Claire Chin Siow Lyn, Goh Teck Koon and Julie Tan were in third.
