# Doctors on a mission

## They aim to stage a musical to raise RM200,000 for charity

**F**OR the first time ever, doctors from government, private hospitals and private clinics in Penang will be coming together for a musical entitled 'Say Ah!!! A Charity Musical Evening With Doctors' on Oct 31.

To be held at the Dewan Sri Pinang, the event aims to raise RM200,000 for the Penang Family Health Development Association's MAY-CARE centre (centre for people living with HIV) for the next two years.

The funds will be used to support

activities such as peer counselling, awareness talks on sexual health, reproductive health, group discussions on HIV/AIDS and others.

The centre caters for more than 500 people comprising those living with HIV or their family members.

The centre also conducts make-up, embroidery, cooking and baking classes to help bring out the hidden talents of those affected and help them market their products as well as assist them in looking for jobs.

Admission to the musical, which starts at 8pm, is by donations of RM150, RM250 and RM500 per ticket. All donations will be issued with tax exemption receipts.
