Wen pledges more effort against AIDS

Premier gratified to see recovering HIV carriers

BEIJING: Premier Wen Jiabao pledged that the government will do more to prevent and control the spread of AIDS.

Wen made the remarks in a meeting with representatives of HIV carriers, children orphaned by AIDS, medical and health science staff, volunteers, petitioners and people from relevant

international organisations in Zhongnanhai, the headquarters of the central government in downtown Beijing.

Wen said he has participated in activities for AIDS prevention and control, spent the Spring Festival with AIDS patients and their family members and met children with AIDS or children orphaned by AIDS in Zhongnanhai

every year during his 10-year tenure.

"I feel gratified seeing that the HIV-carriers I met before are recovering through treatment and the children have grown up. But some HIV carriers and AIDS patients I met have passed away.

"Thinking of them, I always feel that we should do our work better and more meticulously," said Wen. — Xinhua
