Talk on HIV prevention, treatment and eradication

KUCHING: A "HIV prevention, treatment and eradication using animal models" talk will be held at the Sarawak Biodiversity Centre, KM20, Jalan Borneo Heights near here, today.

Dr Zandrea Ambrose, assistant professor with Infectious Diseases Division, School of Medicine, University of Pittsburgh will deliver the talk from 2.30pm.

Ambrose, whose areas of specialisation include understanding the evolution of HIV drug resistance and, identification and eradication of HIV reservoirs, also heads the Ambrose Lab, one of the seven productive research laboratories under the division.

Although there is no cure at the moment for HIV, recent studies have given hope for new treatments to eliminate HIV-infected cells from individuals.
